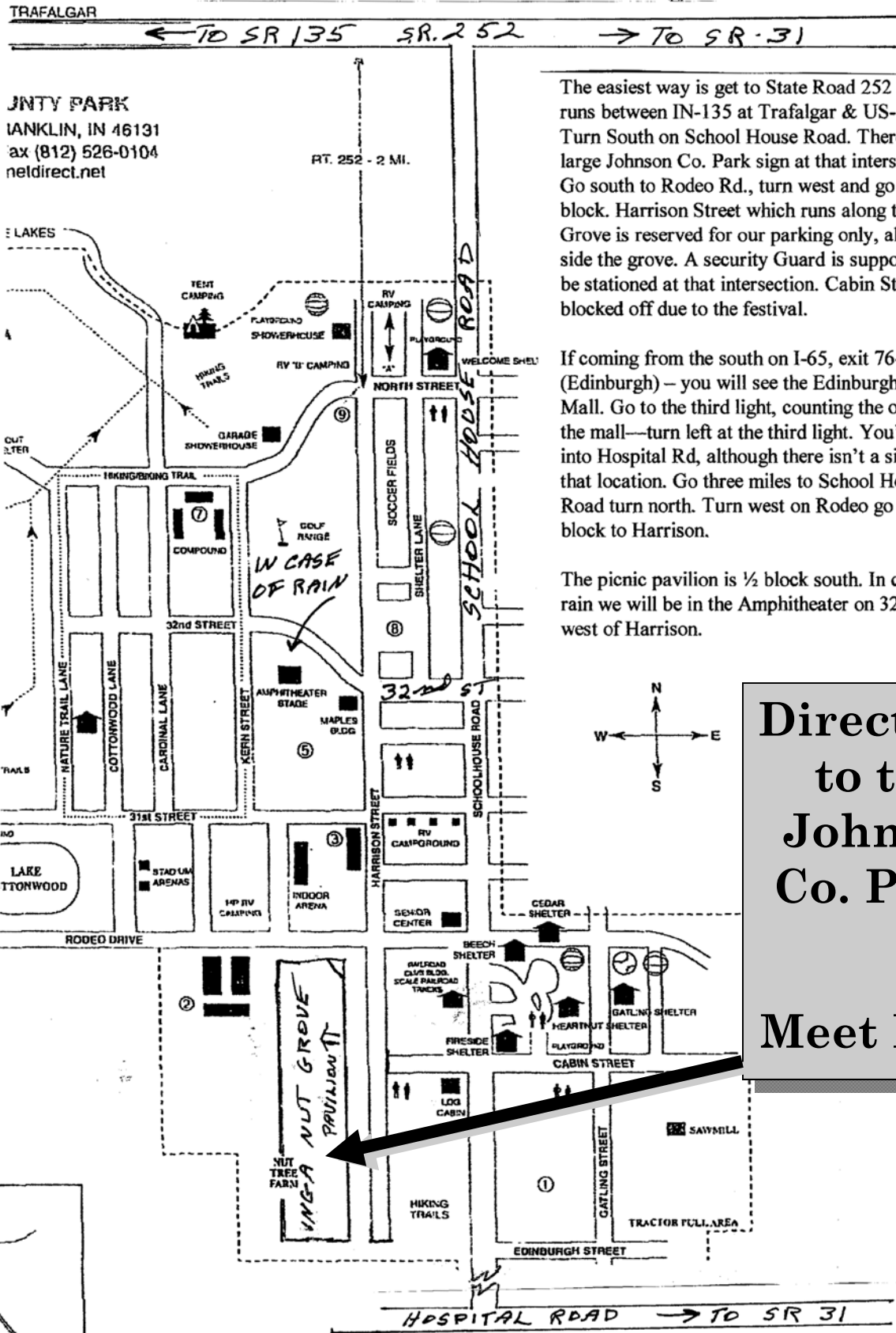

The easiest way to get to State Road 252 which runs between IN-135 at Trafalgar & US-31. Turn South on School House Road. There is a large Johnson Co. Park sign at that intersection. Go south to Rodeo Rd., turn west and go one block. Harrison Street which runs along the Nut Grove is reserved for our parking only, along side the grove. A security Guard is supposed to be stationed at that intersection. Cabin Street is blocked off due to the festival.

If coming from the south on I-65, exit 76-B (Edinburgh) – you will see the Edinburgh Outlet Mall. Go to the third light, counting the one at the mall—turn left at the third light. You’ll turn into Hospital Rd, although there isn’t a sign at that location. Go three miles to School House Road turn north. Turn west on Rodeo go one block to Harrison.

The picnic pavilion is 1/2 block south. In case of rain we will be in the Amphitheater on 32nd St., west of Harrison.
